Highlights of Our Week

Language Arts

The students have time to read each day in class. If the reading isn't completed in class then its homework. A grade will be taken from each chapter from now until the end of the book. We are reading Chapters 9 & 10 next week in *The Keeping Room*. The students may need to read it more than once to grasp the comprehension or purpose of the book. The goal is to complete 2 chapters a week.

In Writer's Workshop, Ms. Lambes reminded the students how important revising is in the writing process. We reviewed suffixes this week. Also, the students worked on using the RACE strategy and complex sentences. We will continue to review subjects & predicts, verb tenses, synonyms & antonyms, & the different kinds of sentences, the differences between fragments, run-ons, & complete sentences. I taught articles, & prepositions.

Math

The assessment will be 2/11/15. We will learn about turning fractions into decimals next. We will learn how to use a place value grid to record decimals & fractions to the tenths & hundredths. Also, we will compare and order decimals. We will move quickly through this unit. The hard unit on geometry will be next.
